4. Presentation-Wyatt McCrea, McCrea Ranch

11. Presentation- Jim Friedl, Conejo Recreation and Park District, Community Collaboration

Jim Friedl, General Manager, shared a PowerPoint presentation on collaboration with local community organizations, and our open space areas. He gave a background of CRPD facilities and its operating budget. Friedl went on to explain partnerships within the community such as the Conejo Valley Botanical Garden and the Chumash Indian Museum. Friedl shared history and benefits of partnerships with the City of Thousand Oaks and the Conejo Valley Unified School District. Friedl concluded the presentation with CRPD's Joint Powers Agreement with MRCA. Friedl answered questions from the group.
