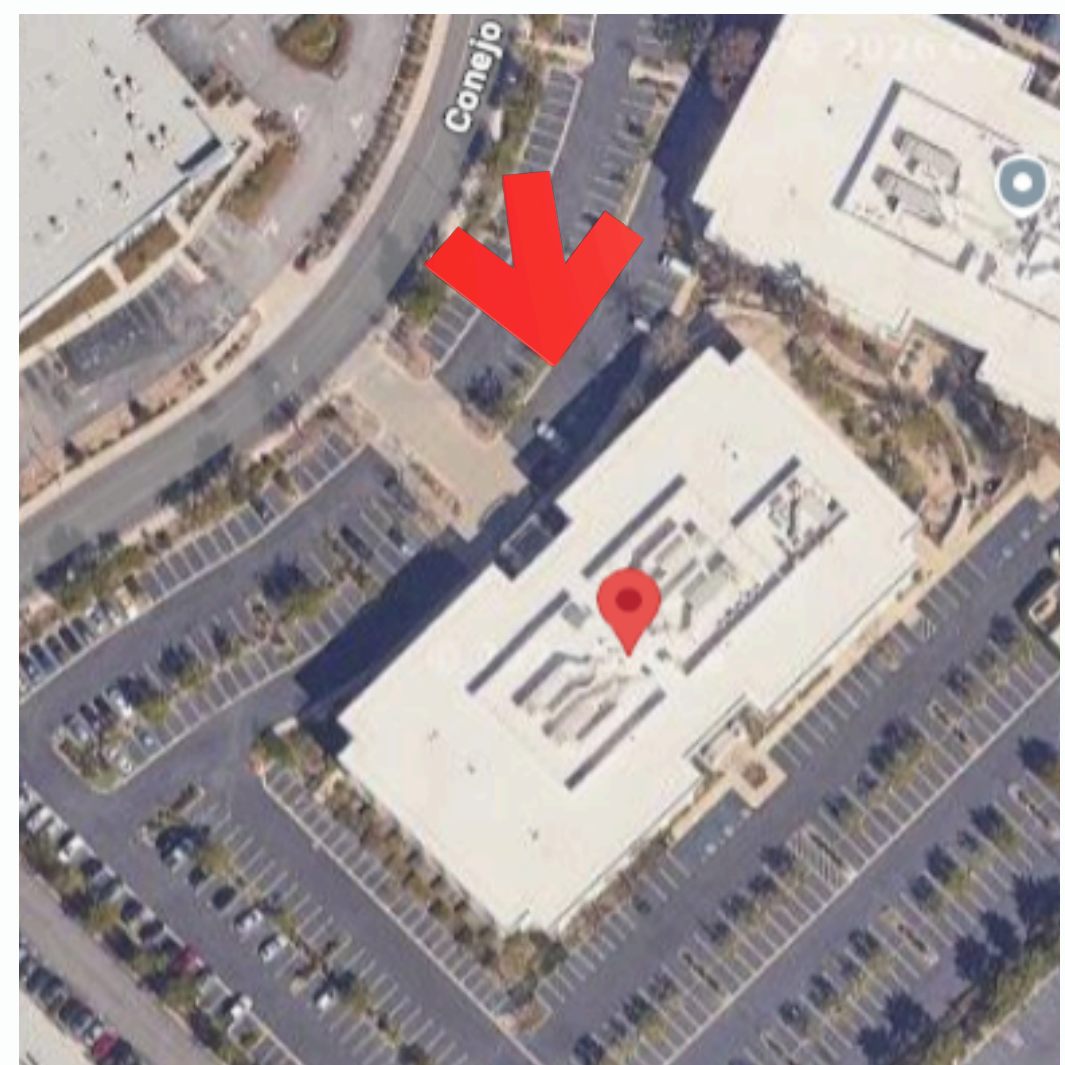
If you wish to tour the new state of the art Fire Station 35, please meet at the station at 5 p.m.

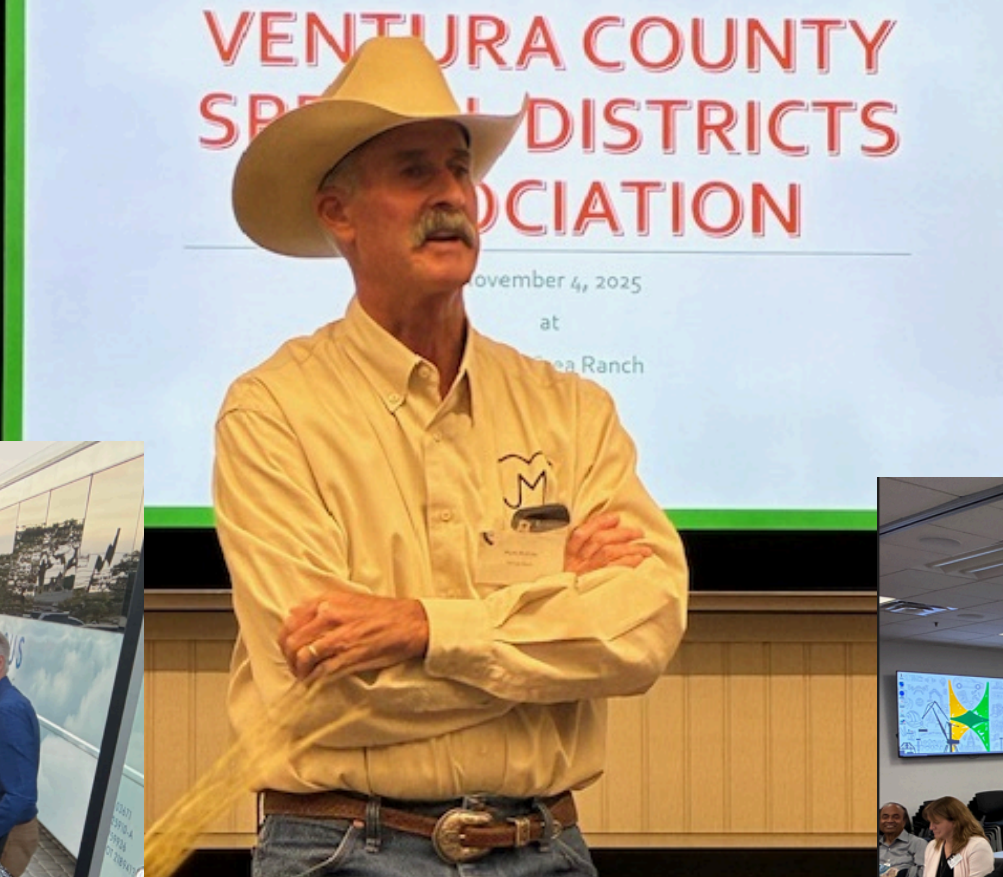
