1. CALL TO ORDER

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: BOARD MEETING JUNE 6. 2023

Motion to approve the Minutes from the June 6, 2023 membership meeting. Elaine Freeman; Second, Bruce Dandy. Voice vote: all in favor, none opposed. Motion carries unanimously.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT

In Mr. Pendleton's absence, President Ralston reported on the June 2023 and July 2023 balance sheets. Motion to receive and file VCSDA Balance Sheets and Profit and Loss Statements from June 2023 and July 2023, Elaine Magner; Second, Daniel Naumann. Voice vote: all in favor, none opposed. Motion carries unanimously.

4. GUEST SPEAKER

President Ralston introduced guest speaker Kai Luoma, LAFCo Executive Officer. Mr. Luoma provided a brief background on the history and conditions that led to the creation of LAFCo's. He provided an overview of LAFCo's funding sources and purposes, including regulating service boundaries and how they determine spheres of influence through municipal service reviews. He mentioned housing development as Ventura LAFCo's current biggest challenge.

5. MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

Todd Mitchell with VPD announced that the port just received a grant for 80 million dollars. Bruce Dandy with UWCD reminded members to join them Thursday, August 3rd, for their celebration of 4 million acre-feet of water recharged. Raul Avila and Thibault Robert with CMWD mentioned their district is getting ready to review the new strategic plan. Elaine Freeman with RSRP announced their 2 million dollar grant to redo a swimming pool. They are also in construction of their lighted dog park.

6. REPORTS

CSDA Report - CSDA President Elaine Magner provided the CSDA report and, also, the CSDA Update, on behalf of Charlotte Hollifield. She reminded members to review the legislative report they received. She shared updates on bills and resolutions being reviewed by CSDA. AB557 is a sponsored bill that is on the homestretch to the Governors desk. SCR52 is a sponsored resolution proclaiming May Special Districts Week. President Magner reminded members of the CSDA Annual Conference & Exhibitor Showcase, August 28-31, where she will also be hosting a reception. She mentioned the Special District Leadership Academy being held in Santa Rosa, October 22-25.

Legislative Update - Director Freeman provided a status of the bills reviewed on the last legislative report emailed out the last VCSDA meeting. She provided an interesting fact to members that it costs the State about \$2200 in labor, per bill, and there are about 2600 bills. She informed the members there is a legislative meeting this Friday and will be able to have more updates after that meeting. LAFCo Update - Director Avila reported that the sphere of influence was approved for several districts.

County Oversight Update - Nothing reported.

7. NEW BUSINESS

Vice President McMillan announced she will be involved in the State Water Project tour.

President Ralston adjourned the meeting at 6:44 p.m. to the next VCSDA meeting **on October 3**, **2023**.

Water is Life!

Thank you for this opportunity to share in the newsletter! Boiling down my recent experience to fit here is impossible but perhaps the relevant (if not obvious!) news is that water is precious, water is life, and excellent, dedicated people continue to protect, conserve and build for the future.

I had the recent opportunity to participate in a 3-day tour of State Water Project facilities (SWPs), including Lake Oroville, Feather River Fish Hatchery Raceway, the future Sites Reservoir, and others. Here are some interesting stats:

- Lake Oroville is the 2nd largest reservoir in CA;
 3.5million acre-ft capacity
- San Luis Reservoir is 5th largest in CA; 2million acre-ft capacity
- One acre-foot is 326,000 gallons and serves three typical CA households
- Salmon spawning is mid-Sept to mid-Nov; Steelhead spawning is mid-Dec to mid-Feb
- When completed, Sites Reservoir will pump up to 640,000 acre-ft of Northern Sierra Mountains runoff

I share this info not only to convey the invaluable role water districts play in communities, but to also convey a small measure of the immense pride I feel in serving the public with each of you. May the Fall season bring rain, in manageable and beneficial amounts, for the continued prosperity of our California!
