TREASURER'S REPORT: Presented by Mark Malloy

Beginning Balance as of 05/01/2019 was \$14,426.88. Ending Balance as of 08/01/2019 was \$15,136.08. *Motion* by Elaine Freeman, *seconded* by Kate O'Brien to approve the Treasurer's Report as submitted. Two abstentions. *Motion carried.*

He thanked Elaine Magner for telling him about CSDA offering a free website to its members. He and Kara Wade participated in training with Streamline. Mark and Kara showed a few features of the new website. The group unanimously agreed to using Streamline for free hosting of the VCSDA website.

REPORTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Legislative Update and CSDA Report: Elaine Magner, Coastal Network Board Member, said that the legislators are not in session until 08/12/19. The next legislative meeting is scheduled for 08/16/19. CSDA is celebrating its 50th year. No report.

Ventura LAFCo Update: Elaine Freeman, Ventura LAFCo Board Member, said that LAFCo will be relocating its offices to 1801 Victoria Avenue tentatively 08/19/19. The move was postponed due to ADA compliance issues. She said that it was determined that Calleguas is exempt from LAFCo for the Calleguas/Ventura interconnection. LAFCo will hold a conference 10/30/19-11/01/19

County Oversight Board Update: Mike Mishler said that there was a meeting but he was unable to attend. No Report.

PRESENTATION

Mike Mishler, provided an informative overview of Ventura County's geologic history. He showed a simulation video graphic of the local plate movements 20 million years ago to the present. He talked about how the local mountain ranges were formed, groundwater aquifers were formed within the region and explained that the Spanish named Carpenteria after Chumash carpenters building boats using natural tar seepage.

NEW BUSINESS

Elaine Magner, Coastal Network Board Member- CSDA, talked about the CSDA Student Video Contest. She said that the contest submission period will run from May 1 to September 30, 2019. She is requesting that VCSDA assist in promoting the contest and supports VCSDA providing scholarships. Mark Malloy, VCSDA Treasurer also supports using VCSDA funds for scholarships. *Motion* by Al Fox, *seconded* by George Lange to approve the scholarship amounts of first place \$500.00, second place \$300.00 and third place \$200.00 as submitted. *Motion carried.*
