President Ralston invited Brian Pendleton with Ventura Port District and Mary Ann Rooney with Oxnard Harbor District to share the news of the \$16 million sub-award from the California State Transportation Agency's Port and Freight Infrastructure Program grant they received to work together on projects to support efficiency of operations for the ports.

President Ralston gave a brief overview of the Camarillo Health Care Districts (CHCD) health and wellness services, highlighting the Care-A-Van transportation services, Adult Day Center, Senior Nutrition Program, and Caregiver services, education and training. She discussed Fall Prevention Services and programs, including SMARTfit, POWERfit, and BALANCEfit. She announced that CHCD won the 2024 Innovative Program of the Year award for BALANCEfit and POWERfit.
